UP DATE ON NATIONAL LICENSING

12th November, 2012

The National Occupational Licensing Authority (NOLA) have established interim Occupational Licensing Advisory Committee (OLACs) for the first wave occupations, providing a forum for industry and the Authority to resolve outstanding issues and to plan for implantation of national licensing in 2013 .

Building and building related occupations, conveyances, and valuers are expected to commence in the new system from 1st July 2013.

Painting will be considered within the discussions of the building license.

As the peak industry body Master Painters Australia will be represented in these discussions.

Master Painters Australia Limited is the peak industry body representing painters and decorators in New South Wales, Queensland, Victoria, Australian Capital Territory, Tasmania and South Australia.

With its aim being to protect and promote the interests of the painting and decorating industry at a National level.

Master Painters Australia will continue to meet with Government and industry representatives to pursue the introduction of a national licensing scheme which will protect and promote the painting and decorating industry at a national level for all contractors, manufacturers, retailers, consumers and support quality training for our industry.
